23.  **Sol de Andes Sauvignon – Central Valley, Chile** £15.95
A fresh zippy wine with aromatic herbal hints, rich citrus fruit and a lovely dry finish.
81.  **Grillo Ceresa– Sicily, Italy** £14.95
Pleasant white wine, with soft green yellow hues. Flavours of exotic rich fruit can be found.
57.  **Bottle Tree Semillon Chardonnay – N.S.W. Australia** £16.50
A clever blend of grapes delivers a fresh and fragrant wine with a long aftertaste.
51.  **Verdejo, Valdelainos – Rueda, Spain** £17.95
An intense yellow colour with tropical and exotic fruits on the nose. Refreshing and easy drinking.
24.  **Forge Mill Chenin– South Africa** £15.95
Lovely tingy fresh flavours with a generous citrusy oiliness in the mouth & a lovely long fresh minerally aftertaste. Wonderfully fresh vibrant & generous.
18.  **Pinot Grigio - La Castella, Italy** £17.50
Bags of fruit with an uplifting note of lemon and lime. The tell tale nuttiness can also be found in this wine.

21.  **Sol de Andes Merlot Rose – Central Valley, Chile** £15.95
Delightful easy drinking wine with a refreshing style.

Red Wine

29.  **Sol de Andes Merlot - Central Valley, Chile** £15.95
A young juicy, fruit driven wine, from the Maule Valley in Chile. Plenty of flavour on the palate.
82.  **Nero d'Avola, Ceresa – Sicily, Italy** £14.95
Pleasant red wine that is fruity, soft and very drinkable.
20.  **Rioja Tinto – Bodegas Sierra Cantabria, Spain** £17.95
Brimming with soft ripe berry fruit the wine is full of flavour with cherries being evident on the nose.
66.  **Bottle Tree Shiraz Cabernet – N.S.W. Australia** £16.50
A bold wine with a velvety texture and fruity palate, that leads to a delicate finish.
6.  **Malbec Chevalier De Famaey - France** £16.95
Full on rich red fruit with the tell tale earthiness of the Malbec grape.
31.  **Forge Mill Shiraz / Cinsault** £15.95
The aromas lead with strawberry/raspberry fruit with hints of lavender and violets. Full flavoured and soft on the palate with plenty of ripe tannins and a long, fruity finish.

White Wine




1.  **Muscadet Chateau de la Ragotiere – Loire Valley, France** £16.60
A pleasing wine that is crisp and refreshing. The palate is delicate and complex with a long lasting finish.
2.  **Macon Peronne, Domaine Bicheron – Burgundy, France** £17.95
Tantalising fruit aromas prepare the palate for the full and gentle flavour of the Chardonnay.
4.  **Chablis Domaine Emile Petit – Burgundy, France** £24.50
Full flavoured steely white wine with lots of character and finesse.
5.  **Sancerre Domaine Brochard – Loire Valley, France** £25.95
Typical yardstick, zesty fruit on the nose. This is balanced with a round palate and elegant acidity.
18.  **Pinot Grigio - Ceresa – Italy** £17.50
Bags of fruit with an uplifting note of lemon and lime. The tell tale nuttiness can also be found in this wine.
25.  **Soave – Corte Adami - Italy** £21.95
The Adami estate produces this fresh and lively wine with a floral palate that is balanced by a clean and bright acidity.
51.  **Verdejo, Valdelainos – Rueda, Spain** £17.50
An intense yellow colour with tropical and exotic fruits on the nose. Refreshing and easy drinking.
23.  **Sol de Andes Sauvignon – Central Valley, Chile** £15.95
A fresh zippy wine with aromatic herbal hints, rich citrus fruit and a lovely dry finish.
27.  **Paul Cluver Chardonnay, Elgin – South Africa** £25.95
Strong powerful Chardonnay flavours burst through in this quality wine. Good balance and an excellent long lasting finish.
26.  **Rams Leap Semillon/Sauvignon – New South Wales, Australia** £19.95
A light straw colour with a tinge of green. The bouquet has traces of lime and lychee that blend in with the citrus and honey on the palate.
53.  **Dreambay Pinot Gris – Matakana, New Zealand** £20.95
This boutique vineyard produces an elegant wine that is full of soft ripe fruit such as peach and pear. The palate is long and creamy.
28.  **Vintage Lane Sauvignon – Marlborough, New Zealand** £22.20
A true example of a fine Marlborough Sauvignon with aromas of capsicum a hint of lime, broadening out to show soft tropical fruits and a lingering finish.

6.  **Malbec Chevalier De Famaey - France** £16.95
Full on rich red fruit with the tell tale earthiness of the Malbec grape.
7.  **Beaujolais Villages de la Folie – Burgundy, France** £17.95
All the hallmarks of a classic Beaujolais can be found here. Pear drops on the nose, cherries on the palate and a full finish.
8.  **Cote du Rhone Château St Roch – Rhone, France** £20.95
A sturdy well made wine from the sun drenched vineyards of the Rhone. Ideal for those of you that like a bigger wine with bold flavours.
9.  **Chateau Doyac - Haut Medoc – Bordeaux, France** £23.50
Aromas of spicy plums, deep fruit on the palate perfectly balanced by ripe tannins which lead through to a full and lasting aftertaste.
11.  **Fleurie Clos de la Roilette – Burgundy, France** £23.50
One of the aristocrats of the Beaujolais region. Always silky smooth on the palate with a wild fruity bouquet.
14.  **Chateaufeuf du Pape Château St Roche – Rhone, France** £30.95
A blend of many different grape varieties deliver a wine with huge bold flavours and a complex, multi-layered palate.
22.  **Chianti Colli Senesi – Italy** £21.95
One of the best wines of Tuscany. This young wine exhibits great levels of fruit and a lively refined palate.
54.  **Rioja Reserva Sierra Cantabria – Spain** £26.95
A delightful mature wine with a silky velvety texture that glides into a delightful long lasting finish.
29.  **Sol de Andes Merlot – Central Valley, Chile** £15.95
A young juicy, fruit driven wine from the Maule Valley in Chile. Plenty of flavour on the palate.
31.  **Forge Mill Shiraz Cinsault** £17.50
The aromas lead with strawberry/raspberry fruit with hints of lavender and violets. Full flavoured and soft on the palate with plenty of ripe tannins and a long, fruity finish.

44.  **Muscadet Chateau de la Ragotiere – Loire Valley, France** £9.50
A pleasing wine that is crisp and refreshing. The palate is delicate and complex with a long lasting finish.
46.  **Chablis Domaine Emile Petit – France** £14.50
Flavoursome white wine with bold firm fruit.
48.  **Rioja Crianza Sierra Cantabria – Spain** £14.65
This red wine is in perfect harmony. Quality spicy fruit aromas are enhanced by just the right amount of gentle wood ageing.
47.  **Pouilly Fume Domaine F. Blanchet – France** £14.95
A refreshing white wine with a bouquet that is zingy, grassy and herbal.
50.  **Chardonnay Sol de Andes Reserve Especial - Chile** £9.95
Attractive bright yellow colour with intense aromas of tropical fruit. Crisp dry wine with a delicate touch of butter and oak.
49.  **Cabernet Sauvignon Sol de Andes Reserve Especial - Chile** £9.95

Connoisseur Wines

White

91.  **Rustenberg 5 Soldiers Chardonnay - Stellenbosch** £45.95
A classic wine from one of the regions best producers. Bold flavours and a complex palate are balanced by a long lasting crisp finish.
92.  **Sancerre 'Cuvee Silex' - Domaine Brochard** £42.95
A splendid example of a Sauvignon based wine. Only the best grapes are selected from the premium Silex vineyard sites. The wine is mellow and mature with a bright freshness.
94.  **Meursault 'Les Tillets' - Domaine Guy Roulot** £51.95
This Meursault based Domaine produce classic white Burgundy. They have managed to show the individual characteristics of the different vineyards that are in their portfolio. Delightful long lasting wine with creamy flavours.
93.  **Puligny Montrachet - Domaine Etienne Sauzet** £53.50
This is a big wine with plenty of texture and multi-layered flavours. The aromas are a mix of floral and fruit flavours. This Domaine would be in most wine critics list of top producers.

Red

95.  **Senorio de San Vicente Rioja** £47.50
Allowed to sleep for over 2 years in American Oak barrels this excellent wine develops a rich velvety texture. The palate is complex and expansive delivering a wine that can be savoured and enjoyed with our meat dishes.
96.  **Amarone Della Valpolicella** £50.00
An intense nose of dried herbs and sweet black fruits. There is an exciting level of fruit on the palate that is backed up by a multi dimensional layered personality.
98.  **Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru Boudriottes Domaine Ramonet** £50.00
A fine example of a great appellation from one of the regions best produces. Elegant red cherries can be found on the nose and the palate is awash with raspberry fruit. All this leads to a finish that is pure and flighty.
97.  **Chateau Sansonnet - Grand Cru St Emilion** £52.50
Dark, intense and loaded with ripe fruit, the tannins are now becoming subtle and round. This makes the wine very approachable for drinking now, although it will continue to develop in the bottle. A stunning wine.
